Finances

- Reviewed Financial Report
- More than 50% of all pledges are on Vanco
- Most others are mailing checks
- Majority of expenses are salaries and utilities
- \$15k was the projected loss/red for the year. As of now/YTD we are \$5K in red
- The only Preschool refunds issued since the last meeting were for fobs
- Move to Accept the monthly financial report as submitted by the Treasurer (Mike Geiger)
- Monthly Report Accepted

Some Parish Survey Results

- Email went to 185 email addresses (based upon those who subscribe to N&N)
- Many of those no longer attend All Saints'
- 92 % of people who participated in the survey, attend online worship
- Average Sunday combined attendance (pre-covid) is 75 people.
- 56% responded "Maybe" regarding participation in in-person worship
- 40% are ready to participate in in-person worship, now
- 100% people want to be socially distant (at least 6 ft)
- Fr Mark will share a pdf version of results so the Vestry can review on their own.

In-person Worship

- All Saints' staff is working on the setup for in-person worship
- Sunday, 9/20 All Saints' will return to in-person worship at 9 am
- The 9 am service will be outdoors, until/unless weather does not permit, then it will move indoors
- 10 am online streaming service will continue
- Participants will have to register if they wish to participate in-person
- There will be a cap of 50 people
- Check-in with Ushers will include temperature check
- Mailing (via USPS) with information will be going out tomorrow, 9/16/2020
- Email with info and registration link will be distributed on Friday, 9/18/2020

Live Streaming Worship at ASC

- Preliminary analysis of new audio/video equipment
- Last Sunday (9/13) Stephen did a parallel test run with new equipment (Mevo)
- Better views and quality compared to what we have been using
- Mevo system intuitive and easy to use
- There is a possibility we may want to upgrade, or add-on to the Mevo
- Perhaps invest in some technology consulting to make sure we move forward with correct equip
- New Ministry: A/V attendant or Virtual Verger
