

Minutes of All Saints' Vestry Meeting

June 15, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:05.

Review of agenda for the evening

Minutes reviewed, motion to accept as recorded, seconded, passed with one abstention

Financial Report

- 1st forgiveness of PPP has been received. Forgiven loan allocated over 12 months, first 5 months put into income.
- Workers Comp paid \$5300, was applied to preschool debt. Insurance gave credit; refund on prepaid workers compensation for 2020
- Pledges continue to be paid in timely matter

Worship

- Kick-Off Sunday September 12
- We will return to two services, 8 and 10 am, the following Sunday, September 19. Social distancing, mask use and contact tracing will be mandatory. Livestreaming will continue for the foreseeable future.
- We have received bids for video system to be used for Sunday services. Many thanks to AV committee Stephen Chan and Kathy Polo for enabling us to offer livestreaming.
- Gary has sent questionnaire to choir members regarding comfort with resuming singing.

Religious Communities

- RCGR in discussion of anti-Semitic bias in our community.
- All Saints will send flowers for Sabbath worship in solidarity with Glen Rock Jewish Center.

Congregation and Vestry Member

- Paul Louis' remains interred in the All Saints' Garth on June 12 in a private family service. The Vestry will split the interment fee (\$500). Any outstanding expense will be covered by the Rector's Discretionary Fund.

Tour of Preschool Space

All vestry members in attendance, plus Fr. Mark and Treasurer Mike Geiger, left meeting in parish hall to tour nursery school space in the chapel building. Fr. Mark has contacted Parades-Grube Architecture in Glen Rock to visit and begin clarifying needs for demolition, code requirements and updates. As the future use of the space has not been established, the suggestions will be preliminary.

General Business

The vestry reconvened in the parish hall, where Fr. Mark thanked all for efforts to keep parish life ongoing throughout the limitations of the pandemic. He suggested a summer break of July in addition to the usual August to recharge before the start of the program year in September, requesting:

- Prayer for knowledge of God's will for us and the power to carry it out.
- Come to church, look at who is there, consider who might join us in leadership.
